

ISN p. 46 Sedimentary Rocks

- Formed by weathering (breaking rocks down into sediment), erosion (moving sediment), and deposition (where sediment accumulates)
- And then compaction and cementation (lithification)
- Three types of sedimentary rocks:
 - Clastic: made of broken pieces and fragments of rocks
 - Chemical: when minerals crystallize directly from water
 - Biochemical: formed by organisms or the remains of organisms
